

## Moree Solar Farm – draft criteria for perceived success in various themes as agreed by MSFCRG 12 November 2014

### 1. Tourism

- Minimise impact on neighbouring properties.

**KPI** open communication between neighbours and the Moree Solar Farm Project. Timely response by project representatives. Neighbours (or a representative) to be provided with a list of people to contact during construction.

Community Success Criteria required action:

*MSF to respond to any neighbour issues raised as a result of concerns regarding increased 'tourist' traffic with 72 hours of report. Reports and follow up actions to be detailed to CRG at meetings.*

- No significant adverse effect on the current tourism industry.
- Minimise impact on community organisations.

**KPI** minimise how many people are turned away because of lack of available accommodation. Ensure community consultation to provide information to community groups as to timing of influx of workers.

Community Success Criteria required action:

*MSF will make available to the CRG reports of number of hotel/motel rooms booked by MSF Project workers.*

*MSF to work with accommodation providers in the event Moree has no available tourist beds to assist with making beds available to tourists and emergency accommodation community groups.*

*MSF to provide CRG with expected accommodation requirements throughout various stages of the project.*

### 2. Employment

No draft criteria as only two people attended meeting, one of which as an interested resident and not as a CRG member.

**MSF initiated KPI** That MSF and its EPC contractor encourage employment of members of the Moree community where relevant skills are available and that opportunities are provided to local businesses to participate in the project.

### 3. Australian Aboriginal opportunities

**KPI** – That the Project should endeavor to hire a number of local Aboriginal Australians.  
**KPI** - Cultural awareness – group discussed the importance of acknowledging traditional owners and the fact that the Project is on Kamilaroi Land.

**KPI** - Raising awareness of Aboriginal culture amongst other workers on the project. Group discussed possibility of Cultural Awareness program for the Project Management team and providing information to other workers.

**Community Success Criteria required action:**

*The Project or sub-contractor shall provide opportunities for the local Aboriginal community to secure employment on the project based on merit.*

*MSF to provide an enduring recognition of the traditional owners of the land on the project site. Eg Plaque/rock on site portraying a big sun (“yurraay”)*

*MSF to acknowledge the traditional owners at various stages of the project.*

*Construction Site induction to include information on the Aboriginal Culture and artefacts management.*

#### **4. Infrastructure**

**KPI** - Traffic Management Plan to ensure safe traffic flows in the area.

**KPI** - Extension of water main – ensure no drop in water pressure for **current** consumers.

**Community Success Criteria required action:**

*MSF to report traffic incidents associated with the project to the CRG.*

*MSF to record any complaint regarding loss of water main pressure received by the project, investigate with Council if associated with the project and report results of investigation to CRG.*

#### **5. Communication with Community**

**KPI** – Maintain effective communication with the community and CRG

**Community Success Criteria required action:**

*MSF meet or exceed community information requirements of the Community Consultation Plan.*
